*A Minority Report* chronicles the experiences of Serbs and other minorities who were displaced from Kosovo following the June 1999 NATO bombing campaign against then-Yugoslavia. The documentary will be introduced and presented by Milica Matijević. She is a lawyer, activist, and freelance consultant on human rights issues. In addition to consulting on *A Minority Report*, she has served as a legal advisor on human rights in a variety of capacities including within the government of Serbia, the UN Development Programme (UNDP), and the Belgrade Center for Human Rights. She is the 2008 recipient of the McCloskey Fellowship, named for the late U.S. congressman Frank McCloskey, which brings one scholar every year from the Balkans to Indiana University and Washington, D.C. to conduct academic research. The focus of her research is on the legal aspects of minority rights and affirmative action in U.S. higher education. She lives in Belgrade.
