Nevertheless, given the fractious nature of regime transformation in the Balkans, the broader Middle East, and Central Asia, policymakers on both sides of the Atlantic increasingly differ on the strategies and goals of democracy promotion. Dr. Kopstein is Professor of Political Science at the University of Toronto where he serves as Director of the Centre for European, Russian and Eurasian Studies. His research lies at the nexus of comparative methodology, post-authoritarian democracy-building, and trans-Atlantic relations.
